Persons of Hispanic origin represent 11.1% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.4% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 63.5 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$104,355 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$113,163 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$137,352 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$153,956 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$52,029 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$58,702 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 45.2% of the 25,121 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 45.2%, renter occupied; and 9.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 22,484 housing units in the area and 8.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 2.64%. Median home value in the area is \$368,688, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.20% annually to \$391,309.
